

## **KETTLE WORKERS POSITION DESCRIPTION**

Three Kettle Workers are needed; they should **report to Towers Saturday, February 24, 2018 at 7:00 AM**; Kettle Workers should finish working about noon. Kettle Workers will:

- Assist Cooks in loading soups into the steam kettles to be reheated.
- Assist Cooks in unloading heated soups into pans for transportation.
- Clean kettles in-between batches.
- After all soups are heated they will assist cooks in cleaning up area.
- Workers will be required to wear a hat or hair restraint in the kitchen; feel free to bring your own hat.
- Workers should have closed toed shoes. Clothing and shoes may get a bit dirty, so dress appropriately.
- Gloves and Aprons will be supplied by the worksite.

Note: The environment may be wet due to kettle cleaning.
